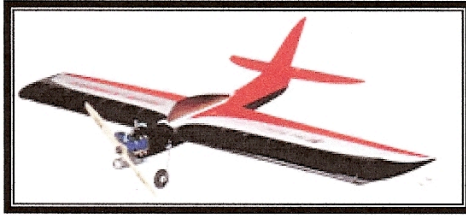


THE FLITE STREAK ARF

An almost-ready-to-fly .25-.35 size control line aerobatic model airplane by Top Flite



The profile Flite Streak ARF is perfect for training, stunt flying, or combat.

FEATURES

Construction: Balsa and plywood

Wings: One-piece, built up balsa

Fuselage: Wooden profile type

Covering: Factory applied Top Flite MonoKote covering (black, white, red)

Canopy: Brown tinted

Landing Gear: Fixed wire with one 1-3/4" foam wheel

Building Time: Ready to fly in only 3-5 hours, bellcrank and leadouts are preinstalled

INCLUDES

One Flite Streak Control Line profile model airplane by Top Flite, decal sheet, metal fuel tank, hardware bag, elevator pushrod, 1-3/4" foam wheel, landing gear wire, photo-illustrated manual

REQUIREMENTS

Engine: .25-.35 cu in 2-stroke, control line type (*O.S. .25 LA-S, Fox .35 or similar is recommended*)

Misc. Items: medium fuel tubing, fuel filter, propeller: 9-4 or 9-5 (.25 engine) or 10-5 or 10-6 (.35 engine), Sig glow fuel (10% nitro/25% castor oil), glow battery, control line cable (0.015 X 60'), 4 line connectors, control handle, heat shrink iron, and miscellaneous building and field equipment.
